What is the pre- summit presentation and it's relationship to the summit presentation

How many people attend WBECS?

Where does WBECS takes place?

WBECS is a completely digital event so each speaker will present from the comfort of their home or office. We will have tutorial sessions prior to the event to run through the logistics of being on the session - which is all incredibly straightforward. You will have a session host and WBECS team on with you to provide immediate assistance should you need guidance to join your WBECS presentation.





How are presentations delivered and what software is used?

WBECS uses GoToWebinar - a digital webinar software that will include live audio of the presentation + presentation slides. There will not be video presentations.
